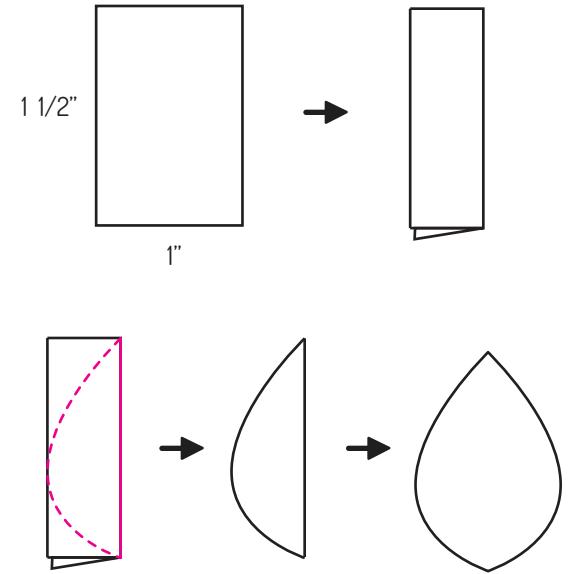


USING THE TEMPLATES

1. Cut out a piece of colored felt using the measurements and color given. Fold this piece of felt in half length wise, unless otherwise noted.
2. Cut out the pink shapes, these are the templates you will use. Lay them over the folded felt pieces.
3. Align the solid line along the crease of the folded felt and use a pencil to trace the dotted line.
4. Remove the template and use scissors to cut out the shape along the traced line.
5. Unfold and follow the DIY instructions for how to assemble.

TIP: If there's a specific flower you would like to make, look up pictures of real flowers, print, take a piece of paper and trace half the petal. Cut out the trace, lay over folded felt and cut out. Have fun and experiment with your own flower creations.

ASSEMBLING THE FLOWERS

The following instructions are step-by-step directions for how to assemble the hydrangea flowers, daisies, succulents, and anemone flowers.*

1. Cut out the felt pieces and templates.

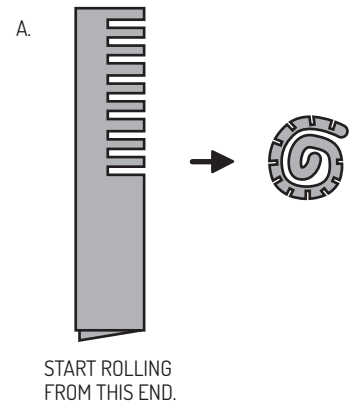
2. Build the center of the flower. See examples A & B.

A. DAISY AND ANEMONE:

Fold and cut the center piece as shown on the Daisy Center & Anemone Center templates. Open the center, apply glue down the side, then re-fold and hold until dry. Starting from the end without cuts, roll the center together and seal the end with glue.

B. SUCCULENT:

Take one of the smallest succulent leaves and roll together, then glue.



3. Glue the petals around the center.

DAISY:

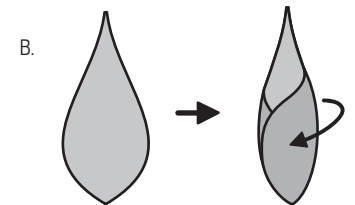
Space the petals evenly around the center.

ANEMONE:

Space 4 petals evenly around the center. Glue the remaining 4 petals behind the first petals, in between the petal gaps.

SUCCULENT:

Like the Rose, continuously glue the leaves around the center, always slightly overlapping the previous petal.

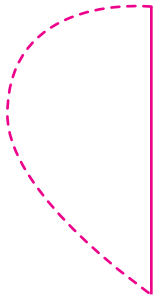

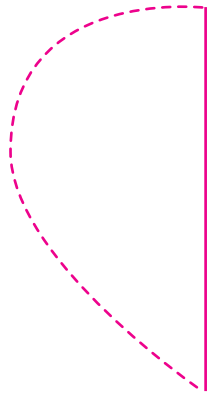

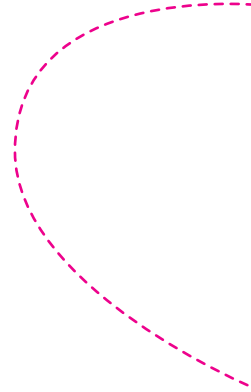
ROSE PETALS #2 (x4)

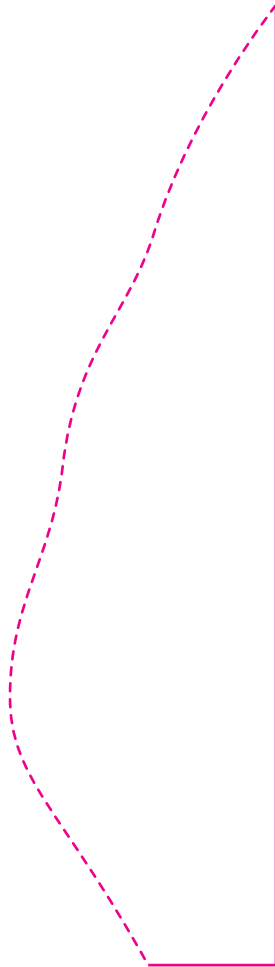

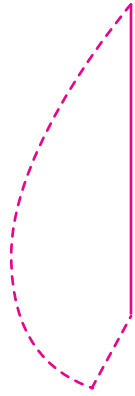

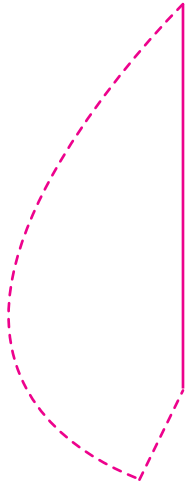

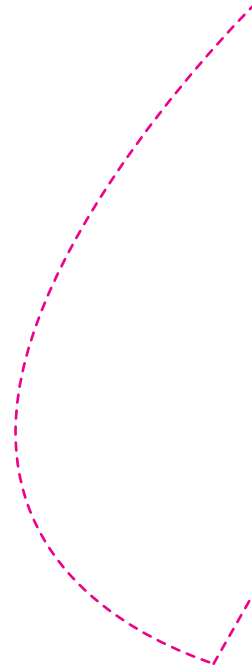

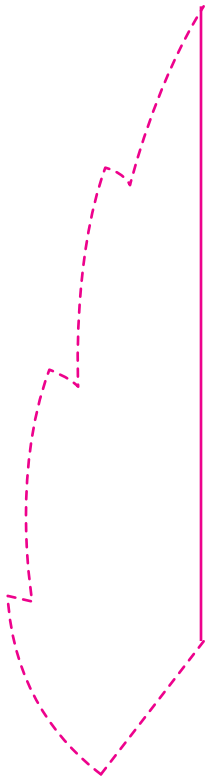

*This template shows the rectangle folded in half. Slide the template halfway from the crease and use scissors to make little cuts down the felt piece.

DO NOT cut past halfway. Once done, keep this folded in half, roll together and glue.



PETALS #1 (x9)
1 1/2" x 2"



CENTER (x1)
2 1/4" x 3/4"

ANY DARK COLOR

← Align this side to crease.

*This template shows the rectangle folded in half. Slide the template halfway from the crease and use scissors to make little cuts down the felt piece.

DO NOT cut past halfway. Once done, keep this folded in half, roll together and glue.

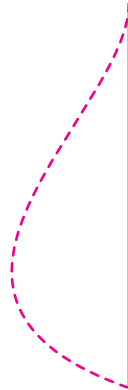

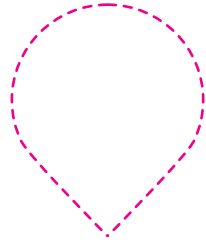

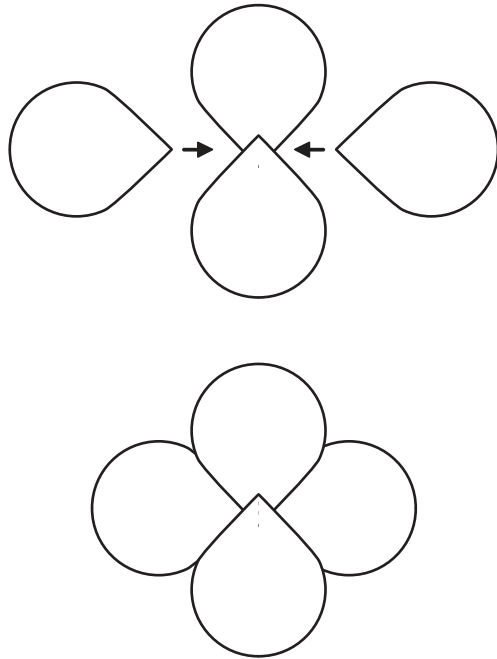

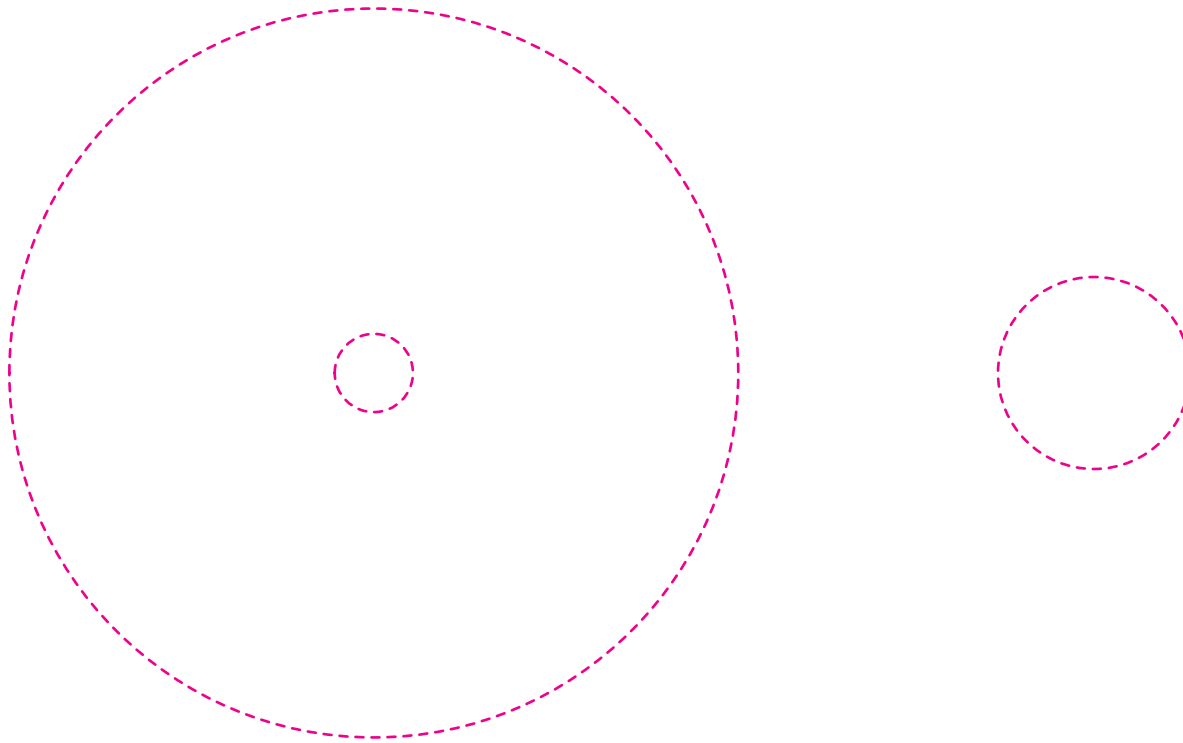
*The amount of flowers needed depends on the size of the foam sphere used. For a 4" foam sphere, plan to make between 50-60 flowers.



HOW TO CUT & ASSEMBLE:

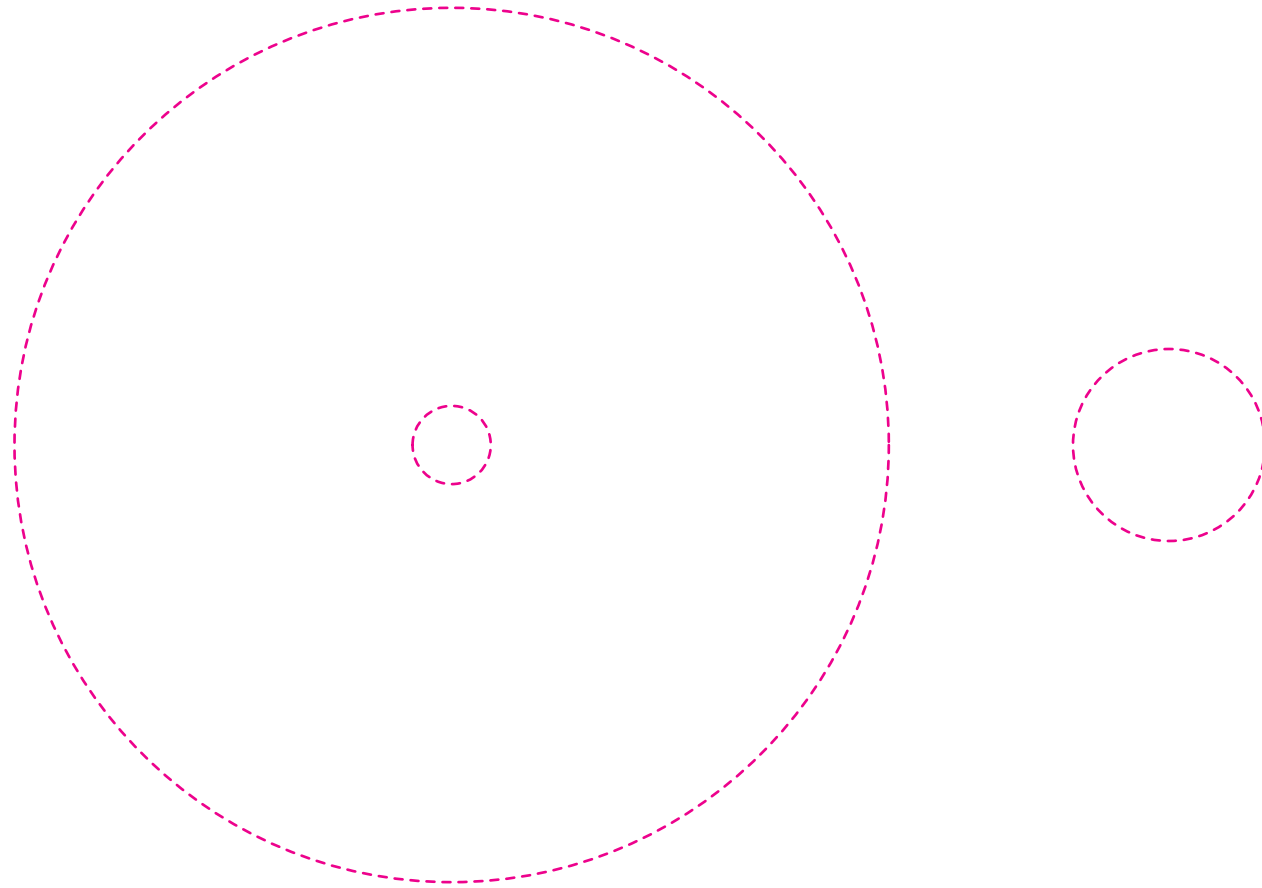
1. Cut out all the flower petals out of felt. Do not fold the felt in half to cut out this flower, simply trace the petal over the 1" square piece of felt.
2. To assemble a flower, apply a dot of glue to the point of one of the petals and place another petal slightly over. Let dry.
3. Apply glue to the point of another petal and place under the two glued petals and let dry. Repeat with the other side.
4. Decorate the center with 4 seed beads.
5. Use a 4" foam sphere as a base and use the glue to completely cover the foam with the finished flowers.
